The SPCA does not guarantee the health or disposition of any animal. There will be no refund of the adoption fee. Any expense incurred after the adoption is the sole responsibility of the adopter. The SPCA will not be held accountable for any health or injury that may occur to either animals or people due to the newly adopted pet(s). All animals from the SPCA must be spayed or neutered by the age of 7 months. If the animal is under the age of four months at the time of adoption, the adopter(s) will be responsible for having the animal spayed or neutered at their own expense per the adoption contract. If the adopter does not spay or neuter the animal to complete the contract, a fine may be issued and the animal must be returned. You must be 18 years of age or older to adopt. We do include heartworm testing for dogs over the age of six months. We also offer parvovirus and FIV/FELV testing at an additional cost to the adopter that can be done prior to adopting. If for some reason the adopter is unable to keep the pet, they may return the animal to the SPCA free of charge and without refund. Only completed applications with a proper form of picture ID will be considered for adoption.

The Lenoir County SPCA reserves the right to refuse adoptions.
